


Matrix Foot-rest removal to fit vent for footwell heater




Plastic Pin pulls out. May require a bit of wiggling around






Remove 2 x 35mm T25 self-tappers which hold the bottom section of the centre dash, 2 eitherside..

No need to completely remove this section it allows you to push back to aid removal and refitting of the plastic foot rest.




Plastic expansion Pin
go here.
6mm nut goes here

Remove 2 x 25mm T25 self-tapping
screws, which hold the top of the foot
rest to the underside of the large plastic
moulded cover around the steering
column. These are quite easy to see.




Remove 2 x 25T self-tapping screws, one either side. This allows the large plastic cover to drop down. You simply lift it completely out the way.

This is normally a small storage pocket, to the right of the steering column



The 2nd 2mt self-tapping screw



Cut a 60mm and 45mm hole using cheap hole saws from Screwfix



View of vents from rear



I used an old pill to direct the air flow to the vent, this was held in place with 3 small self-tapping screws.
I didn't put anything on the smaller vent at the top.



Ready to refit



Fitted back in place



Job done, you wouldn't believe it.
I now have lovely warm feet
